BEAUTIFUL AND DANGEROUS!!

Snow removal in Newtown Grant is a process and we want to keep you updated!! Please read this important winter information!!

Streets - Newtown **Township** plows all streets in Newtown Grant. Please direct all complaints to the Township. There is a place to reach Public Works on the Township website. Please follow this link: <u>http://www.newtownpa.gov/report-a-concern-to-newtown-township/</u>

Using this format will email the Public Works Director and he will see your snow complaint, pothole complaint, street light complaint, etc. Please direct all snow complaints to the Public Works Department of Newtown Township, 215-968-2800 extension 246.

Sidewalks - the sidewalks in front of your home and in the back, for those that back up to the street, are your responsibility to clear within 24 hours after a snow event has stopped. This is not just a convenience issue, this is a safety issue. Please keep the corners free for the children waiting on the school bus. The Board of Directors is meeting with the Township to help alleviate some of the snow removal concerns. Thank you for your support and assistance with this important maintenance item!!

Removing Parked Cars from the street - To allow the Township to clear the roads, please remove parked cars from the roadway to avoid damage from the plow trucks or to avoid being towed. You may use the softball field recreation parking lot. It is not monitored, but it will be plowed within 48 hours after the storm.

Fire Hydrants - if you live near a fire hydrant, please remove the snow from 3 feet around the hydrant.

IS YOUR MAILBOX SNOW REMOVAL READY?

Single-family home mailboxes along the curb should be inspected to be sure they are sturdy enough to withstand the winter weather.

Newtown Township has requested that you be sure to install your mailbox within the USPS guidelines of at least 6-8 inches from the curb. Newtown Township recommends 15 inches from the curb.

Please be sure to check plastic mailbox posts for brittle and cracked areas that will appear over time. Is the wooden post leaning? Rotting? Those mailboxes leaning into the roadway will not be eligible for replacement if knocked over by the plow drivers.

The Newtown Grant Fantasy Football League has ended for 2018. Out of 12 competitive fantasy football teams, three great teams have emerged to be the best!


Third Place is awarded to "More than a Thielen" Second Place is awarded to "The Avengers"






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
