#### Action:

The Board also agreed to reclass the Pool Capital expenses to Reserves.  The Board agreed to rollover the CD at Trumark for 13 mos at 2.80%. Also, ask Monument if they will also give the 2.80% rate for the February CD maturing.

- The Board agreed to have management call Glenn Forsyth to inspect the Banquet Room capacity limit.
- The Board agreed to meet with Miceport and review and update the NewtownGrant.org website. The new site has been up and running for 2 years now. Time to review what is working and what could be changed.
