



ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW BOARD GUIDELINES

FOR

LANDSCAPING AND YARD MAINTENANCE

1. Grass not to exceed eight (8") inches in height.
2. There may be no bare spots in the lawn.
3. Lawn should be treated for weed control.
4. Beds must be mulched, edged and weeded on a regular basis throughout the growing season.
5. Shrubs are to be trimmed so as not to appear overgrown or to infringe on another property.
6. Leaves are to be removed from the lawn in the fall.
7. Dead plantings are to be removed and replaced in a timely manner.
