Appeals

<u>285 Sequoia</u> The homeowner asked the board to approve his pergola with side curtains since itt was installed around 2013-2014 and there was never before an issue with it

<u>42 Tamarack The</u> owner called management to reschedule his appeal for his gazebo violation. <u>Addendum</u> The board decided to <u>deny</u> 285 Sequoia owner s appeal and a letter was sent. The owner asked to appeal the Newtown Grant master board. However, the master board would not override a cluster board decision. Management checked with legal about if the homeowner would further pursue the issue in the courts. The association's attorney Stefan Richter said if the owner went court, a judge would most likely rule in favor of the homeowner since the structure was there for many years. He suggested to grandfather both structures in with the stipulation if one or both homeowners moved, they would have to remove the pergola /gazebo. The board voted in favor of grandfathering in both pergola and gazebo.
